















Manoah ran back with his wife and asked, 'Are you the man who talked to my wife the other day?' 'Yes,' he replied.
















A few days later Samson went back to marry her. On the way he left the road to look at the lion he had killed, and he was surprised to find a swarm of bees and some honey inside the dead body.













She immediately told the Philistines and the thirty men of the city went to Samson with the answer to his riddle.

They told him, 'We have come here to tie you up, so we can hand you over to them.' Samson said, 'Give me your word that you won't kill me yourselves.'









The Philistine kings met together to celebrate and offer a great sacrifice to their god Dagon. They sang, 'Our god has given us victory over our enemy Samson!'












Having A Willing Heart for God

Having a good attitude and patience when helping a sibling Doing nice things without "getting credit" or telling everyone about it


Can you think of others ways to have a willing heart?

We can see how Samson's poor choices caused great problems in his life and how we can avoid many of these problems by following God's word and trusting in our parents for guidance.

What can we learn about "love and marriage" from Samson's sin? It is better to marry someone of your own faith.

There is danger in marrying an unbeliever. The woman looked good to Samson but no mention is made of her heart.

"Charm is deceitful, and beauty is vain, but a woman who fears the Lord is to be praised." Prov. 31:30

Samson was not as wise as he should have been. He relied more on himself than on God. But in his last days his faith was renewed in God.

3 Requirements of a Nazerite

Number 6:1-8

- 1. Abstain from wine
- 2. Never cut his hair
- 3. Don't go near a dead body, even a family member

"And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to the people of Israel and say to them, When either a man or a woman makes a special vow, the vow of a Nazirite, to separate himself to the Lord, he shall separate himself from wine and strong drink. He shall drink no vinegar made from wine or strong drink and shall not drink any juice of grapes or eat grapes, fresh or dried. All the days of his separation he shall eat nothing that is produced by the grapevine, not even the seeds or the skins. "All the days of his vow of separation, no razor shall touch his head. Until the time is completed for which he separates himself to the Lord, he shall be holy. He shall let the locks of hair of his head grow long. "All the days that he separates himself to the Lord he shall not go near a dead body. Not even for his father or for his mother, for brother or sister, if they die, shall he make himself unclean, because his separation to God is on his head. All the days of his separation he is holy to the Lord."
