
## Lesson 21: Goliath 1 Samuel 17

King Saul and the Israelites were camped in Elah Valley. A man named Goliath, from the city of Gath, came out from the Philistine camp to challenge the Israelites.








He often had to protect the sheep from attacks by lions and bears. His three oldest brothers Eliab, Abinadab, and Shammah were in the army facing the Philistines.


















"Go, and the LORD be with you,' Saul replied. He gave David his armor but when David tried it on he said, 'I can't fight with all this, I'm not used to it.' 003



















David told Saul, 'I can't even move with all this stuff on me. I'm not used to this.' And he took it all off.






























