

Canaan was a good land flowing with milk and honey. But this beautiful land was filled with the wickedness of the Canaanite people who lived there.
















And as Joshua looked to the Lord for help, a strange thing happened!

Surely no soldiers ever heard orders such as Joshua's men heard from their leader! But the men were encouraged when Joshua told them...


































God promises a life of victory for Christians on the same condition! Have faith in the Lord, obey His commands, be strong and very courageous. (Ephesians 6:10-11).









































Obey God and we will have victory. Without God we will always lose.
